TROJAN CHECK- KEY MESSAGES



Through Project Restart, USC researchers, staff, faculty, students, and Keck medical professionals will begin returning to campus.



As a condition of returning to campus, USC will need to train and monitor the health of anyone, including USC community members, returning to campus.



Use of the Trojan Check web app will help prevent overcrowding on campus. It is available in English and Spanish and will be tied to a location system that will help enforce physical and social distancing.



You must complete and clear a daily mandatory Wellness Assessment to receive a color-coded pass. You must present your pass to security personnel at an entry point to gain access to the campus.

Trojan Check data is viewed only by authorized personnel for statistical and safety purposes and will remain confidential.

STEP 1: COMPLETE REQUIRED TRAINING

USC University of Southern Californ

This course provides basic health, hygiene and safety information for USC employees and students permitted to return to work on campus during the "Safer at Home" orders (Los Angeles County Department of Public Health). This module was developed by USC Student Health and Keck Medicine of USC in conjunction with USC Environmental Health and Safety in May 2020.

HEALTH, HYGIENE, AND SAFETY TRAINING FOR EMPLOYEES:

- You must compete training <u>before making a reservation</u> to come_to campus
- The course provides information on:
 - How to take the appropriate safety measures to stay healthy while on campus
 - The wellness assessment questions that will be found in the Trojan Check web app
- You must acknowledge completion of the course
- Ensure that you "exit" once you complete the course
- A Spanish version of this course will be available in TrojanLearn

STEP 2: TROJAN CHECK APPLICATION - ACCESS

Access Trojan through an Apple or Android mobile app or laptop/desktop web browsers. Functionality is the same across PCs, Macs, and mobile apps.

Complete the wellness assessment before arriving to campus.

For a Spanish version of the assessment, click "Espanol" in the upper right-hand corner of the screen

COMPLETING THE ASSESSMENT

Read and respond to all questions - if you answer "yes" to any question you will not be allowed to come on campus

SUBMIT ASSESSMENT

Attest to your answers and submit your completed assessment

STEP 3: TROJAN CHECK APPLICATION - WELLNESS CHECK

DAY PASS

Once you submit your wellness assessment with all "no" answers, you will receive a color-coded badge for today's date. The color of the badge will change depending on the day of the week.

PRESENTING A PASS ON CAMPUS

Upon arrival to campus, you will present this pass at a campus entry point. You may either print the pass from a desktop computer or use the QR code on a mobile device.

STEP 4: TROJAN CHECK APPLICATION - REQUEST ACCESS*

REQUEST ACCESS Log in to <u>trojancheck.usc.edu</u> to request access to a room <u>before arriving</u> to campus

COMPLETE REQUEST FORM

Schedule a room to be booked for a specific date and time

SUBMIT REQUEST

Submit the completed form to ensure your space is reserved

Return to the homepage to complete the wellness assessment before going to campus

TROJAN CHECK APPLICATION - GUEST ACCESS

CAMPUS GUESTS, VISITORS AND VENDORS

- Guest access is required for guests, visitors and vendors who do not have USC credentials.
- Employees will need to inform guests/visitors/vendors that they must access Trojan Check as a Guest, complete the wellness check, and get a pass before coming to campus.
- Guests will need to present a printed pass or digital image of the pass at a campus entry point.
- USC employees should refer guests to the Guest Access video on the Keep Teaching or Keep Working website for instructions.
